

# COVID-19 DISTRICT PLAN

RISK LEVEL		
<b>MINIMAL RISK</b>	<p><b>REGARDLESS OF THE RISK LEVEL THROUGHOUT THE REMAINDER OF THE PANDEMIC, EVERYONE IS ASKED TO DO THE FOLLOWING:</b></p> <p>Stay home if you are sick</p> <p>Maintain physical distance of 6 feet from others (outside of immediate family) whenever possible</p> <p>Wear face coverings in public when physical distancing is not possible</p> <p>Wash hands frequently for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer</p> <p>Large gatherings asked to implement: physical distancing, use of face coverings by staff and participants, increased sanitation measures, and increased personal hygiene measures (handwashing/hand sanitizing)</p> <p>Parents are encouraged to take student's temperatures before sending them to school</p>

<b>MODERATE RISK</b>	<p>Rate of Active Cases &gt; 10/10,000 population sustained for 3 days</p> <p>Approximate active cases by county to reach above rate:</p> <p>Bannock: 88</p> <p>Bingham: 47</p> <p>Power: 8</p> <p>(Idaho's current ICU admission rate is 1.5% of all positive current rate, the above numbers of active cases could yield 4 ICU admissions every 10 days in southeastern Idaho.)</p> <p>Hospitals' ICU bed capacity reaches 90% 2-3 times per week (surge capacity still available)</p>	<p><b>IN ADDITION TO THE CONTINUATION OF ALL MITIGATION STRATEGIES FROM THE MINIMAL RISK LEVEL, THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATIONS WILL BE MADE</b></p> <p>Strongly suggest face coverings while at school and on bus</p> <p>Try and limit gatherings to no more than 150</p> <p>Maintain 6' distance between every student whenever possible</p> <p>Encourage vulnerable populations to take extra precautions</p> <p>Provide telework/packets to those students that are unable to attend school</p> <p>Provide hand sanitizer in each classroom</p> <p>Clean and sanitize building and buses regularly</p> <p>Classroom treats must be left at the front office</p> <p>Indicate a meeting place outside of the building to meet siblings and parents</p> <p>Call ahead to check out students and meet students outside of building</p> <p>Strongly suggest athletes to wear masks while on bus and while not participating in the event. Students who feel ill should not attend school or participate in the event</p>

<p><b>HIGH RISK</b></p>	<p>Rate of active cases &gt; 20/10,000 population, sustained for 3 days</p> <p>Approximate active cases by county to reach above rate:</p> <p>Bannock: 176 Bingham: 94 Power: 15</p> <p>(Idaho's current ICU admission rate is 1.5% of all positive cases. Based on this current rate the above numbers of active cases could yield 7 ICU admissions every 10 days in Southeastern Idaho)</p> <p>Hospitals' TOTAL: bed capacity is reaching 90% 2-3 times per week (surge capacity still available)</p>	<p><b>IN ADDITION TO CONTINUATION OF ALL MITIGATION STRATEGIES FROM MINIMAL RISK LEVEL:</b></p> <p>Mandatory face coverings while at school and on bus</p> <p>Try and limit gatherings of no more than 50 at one time</p> <p>Provide telework/packets to those students that are unable to attend school</p> <p>Encourage vulnerable populations to take extra precautions</p> <p>Limit unnecessary visits to school/classrooms</p> <p>Parents/siblings can pick up students outside of the school building (identify a meeting place.)</p> <p>Provide hand sanitizer in each classroom</p> <p>Clean and sanitize buildings and buses regularly</p> <p>Classroom treats must be left at the front office</p> <p>Indicate a meeting place outside of the building to meet siblings and parents</p> <p>Call ahead to checkout students and meet students outside of building</p> <p><i>Athletic events will be played on a day to day basis based on the knowledge of infections among the athletes.</i></p> <p><i>The district will stay in contact with the Southeastern Health Department</i></p>
<p><b>CRITICAL RISK</b></p>	<p>Hospital capacity, including ICU, consistently at or above 100% and surge capacity cannot be maintained</p> <p>Crisis Standards of Care Implemented</p>	<p><b>STAY AT HOME ORDER</b></p> <p>Faculty and staff will attend school as an essential worker</p> <p>Students will receive instruction while at home through various methods</p> <p>No after school/extra curricular events will be sponsored by the school district as recommended by CDC and/or the Idaho High School Athletic Association</p> <p>Buildings will be closed to the public</p>
<p><b>SYMPTOMS AT SCHOOL</b></p>	<p>Notify health officials, staff and families immediately of a possible case while maintaining confidentiality consistent with applicable federal and state laws</p> <p>Close off areas used by a symptomatic individual and do not use before cleaning and disinfecting.</p> <p>Advise symptomatic staff members and students not to return until they have met state and local health department official guidelines</p> <p>Inform those who have had close contact with the person diagnosed with COVID-19 to follow state and local health guidelines.</p> <p>The sick room will be a place where anyone who exhibits COVID-like symptoms can stay until they can leave the school building.</p>	

<b>Transportation</b>	<p>Clean and sanitize buses regularly</p> <p>Air buses out when not in use and appropriate</p> <p>Encourage siblings and students from same household to sit together</p> <p>Eliminate field trips until little or no spread is occurring</p>	<p>Parents may transport their own children to and from school to avoid close contact</p> <p>Unnecessary field trips should be avoided until minimal to no risk is in effect</p> <p><i>Parents may transport their own children to athletic events or have students wear masks while on the bus</i></p>
<b>Serving Meals</b>	<p>Ensure everyone washes hands or uses hand sanitizer prior to entering cafeteria</p> <p>Use disposable trays and utensils</p> <p>emphasize that food, drinks, and utensils are not shared</p>	<p>Students will be asked not to linger in the lunch room and to maintain social distancing whenever possible.</p>

## WHAT IF SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 ARE PRESENT?

- Stay home if sick. **Do not come to school if you have a fever of 100.1 or higher**
- Practice physical distancing.
- Practice good hand hygiene.
- Cover cough and sneezes.
- Wear cloth face coverings in public places. Mandatory in hallways if a case is reported in school
- Disinfect surfaces and objects regularly.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- **The temperature will be taken of any student suspected to be ill.**

### **YOU MAY DISCONTINUE SELF-ISOLATION WHEN:**

- At least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement of respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath)
- At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

**If you have been exposed make sure to self-isolate and call your health care provider.**

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
